

Mainstream Grant Delay -

Statement from Everett Haughton, Funding and Development Officer, London Borough of Tower Hamlets:

“Dear Colleague

Unfortunately, there is a continuing delay in our plans to launch the MSG application process - please accept my apologies for this delay. I am hopeful however that the process will be signed-off in the very near future. Once this happens, organisations will be contacted and provided with information on how to access the on-line application form and associated guidance documents. We will also provide details of the timeline and process from receipt of application through to the successful projects commencing their delivery of services.

- How will your project ensure that equalities & diversity is taken into account?
- What outcomes will your project achieve?
- What is the anticipated project budget and how will this be financed?
